Our Programs

Caviar/Hoppers (6 weeks to 15 months)

- A 4 to 1 ratio/5 to 1 ratio
- Private sleeping area with full-size cribs
- Screened in three-season porch
- Fenced outdoor area
- A variety of equipment available to support and develop gross and fine motor skills.
- Oversized room encompassing areas for different developmental stages.
- Daily communication sheet provided.

Polliwogs (15 months to 24 months)

- A 5 to 1 ratio
- A variety of equipment available to support and develop gross and fine motor skills.
- Separate fenced outdoor play area providing ample variety and space for active play.
- Theme based curriculum with an emphasis on early learning and self-help skills.
- Daily communication sheet provided.



Tadpoles (24 months to 36 months)

- A 6 to 1 ratio
- Separated into Tadpoles 1 and Tadpoles 2 according to developmental level and age.
- Lofted area for quiet time, reading and specific types of play.
- Separate fenced outdoor play area providing ample space and age appropriate activities.
- Theme based curriculum.
- Daily communication sheet provided.
- A teamwork approach to toilet training between families and teaching staff.

Nursery (3 to 4 years)

- An 8 to 1 ratio
- An oversized room with distinct learning areas including a loft and educational computer.
- Hands on theme based curriculum encompassing art, language, math, science and social skills.
- Large playground with areas for swinging, climbing, sitting, biking, etc. with shaded areas for comfort.





Open Year Round
6.30am - 5.30pm

Preschool (4 to 5 years)

- A 12 to 1 ratio
- Large room with distinct learning areas, including a loft and educational computer.
- Theme based curriculum with an emphasis on pre-reading skills.
- Large playground with areas for swinging, climbing, sitting, biking, etc. with shaded areas for comfort.

Kindergarten (5 to 6 years)

- A 15 to 1 ratio
- Large room with lofted reading area and educational computer.
- A theme-based and comprehensive curriculum with an emphasis on letter and number recognition and penmanship through worksheets and short writing activities.
- A focus on developing verbal skills through simple oral presentations.
- An emphasis on improving reading skills through teacher guided group reading and sight word recognition.
